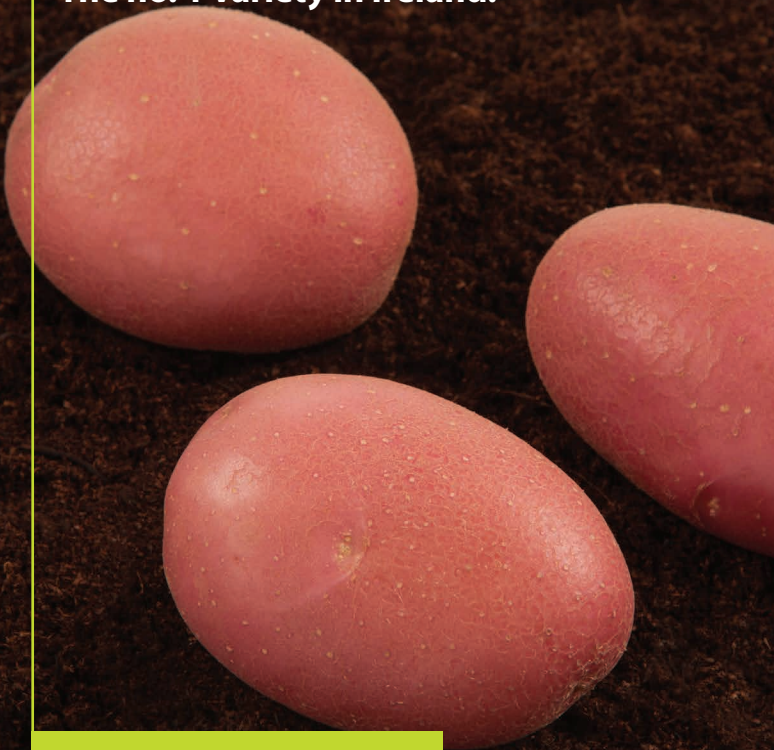

Growing Advice

- Do not damage sprouts before or during planting.
- Good early season blight control is important.
- Manage storage to prevent silver scurf development.
- **Herbicide sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used pre-emergence only.
