Growing Advice

- **SAVANNA** is water efficient. Excessive irrigation may lead to damage to lenticels.
- **Herbicide Sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used **strictly pre-emergence only**. Severe yellowing of leaves will occur if plants are emerging at time of application.
