Growing Advice

- **SHANNON** will bulk very fast and produce large tubers therefore close inter-row spacing will be required.
- Susceptible to PMTV and TRV; avoid high risk sites.
- **Herbicide Sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used pre-emergence only.
