

# BURREN

Great variety for Mediterranean-like climates. **BURREN** is a long oval potato with shallow eyes, good drought resistance and good storage capability. It is very high yielding and produces larger crops compared to Spunta.

## Growing Advice

- A comprehensive fungicide programme is important to protect against late blight.
- **Herbicide sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used pre-emergence only.
