
SAVANNA

- SAVANNA is water efficient. Excessive irrigation may lead to damage to lenticels.
- Herbicide Sensitivity: Metribuzin can be used strictly pre-emergence only. Severe yellowing of leaves will occur if plants are emerging at time of application.
