A high dry matter potato for crisping, it keeps very well in store and fry colours are good right through the storage season. **SETANTA** is very high yielding, has very good resistance to foliage and tuber blight, gangrene and dry rot. A great variety to grow and store. It is also suitable for fresh use and very suitable for Organic production.

Growing Advice

- Close inter-row spacing is required to prevent oversize tubers.
- Careful management of N is required to prevent excessive canopy growth and reduced dry matter.
- Susceptible to spraing – avoid high risk sites.
- **Herbicide Sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used pre-emergence only.
