Growing Advice

- As is a prolific producer of tubers, wide inter row spacing is recommended.
- Responds to higher levels of fertilisation.
- A comprehensive early season fungicide programme is important to protect against late blight.
- **Herbicide Sensitivity:** Metribuzin can be used strictly pre-emergence only.
