

Growing Advice

- As Santiago produces high tuber numbers, extend inter-row seed spacings to deliver larger size in the crop
- · Santiago is a late maturing variety, so avoid excessive application of N and K. A fertilisation programme as per maincrop varieties is recommended, but where earlier maturity is required, reduce rates accordingly
- Herbicide sensitivity Metribuzin can be used pre-emergence only
